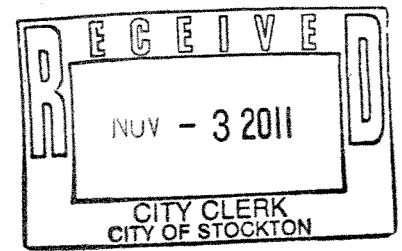


CLAIM FOR DAMAGES

City of Stockton



Note: Claims for bodily injury or death, damage to personal property, or damage to growing crops must be filed on City of Stockton form F1366 no later than six months after the occurrence out of which the claims arose. All other claims must be filed on this form not later than one-year after the occurrence out of which the claims arose. (Refer to California Government Code sections 910.4. and 911.2)

Direction: The original claim must be filed with the City of Stockton City Clerk's office, 425 North El Dorado Street, Stockton, California 95202. Retain the yellow copy for your records.

WHEN DID INJURY OR DAMAGE OCCUR? When the Stockton City Council adopted a redistricting proposal on June 2, 2011.

HOW DID THE INJURY OR DAMAGE OCCUR? The injury occurred when the City of Stockton announced, submitted and subsequently adopted a plan to change the boundary lines of each City Council District that involved noncontiguous voting districts.

NAME OF THE CITY EMPLOYEE (S) INVOLVED? City of Stockton Clerk, Bonnie Page and Former City of Stockton Clerk, Katherine Gong Meissner

WHAT ACTION or INACTION OF CITY EMPLOYEE (S) CAUSED YOUR INJURY OR DAMAGES? The city is specifically failing to follow its own charter, which maintains that City Council District line should be drawn in a Contiguous manner. Mr. White believes that the redistricting lines as drawn are meant to directly discourage him from running for public office or alternatively to make it impossible for him to be elected to public office. The city gerrymandering in the fashion it did, also disenfranchised those voters who have had the opportunity to support Mr. White in the past and, but for the city's actions as have been alleged, would have done so in the future.

WHAT INJURIES OR DAMAGES DID YOU SUFFER?

Violation of the Civil Rights under the 1st and 14th Amendments guaranteeing the right to a representative government.

Violation of Civil Rights pursuant to 42 U.S.C. Section 1983

Intentional Infliction of Emotional Distress with related physical pain upset caused by adoption into law of a redistricting plan which makes it impossible for Mr. White to be elected to City Office in Stockton.

Negligent Infliction of Emotional Distress related physical pain upset caused by adoption into law of a redistricting plan which makes it impossible for Mr. White to be elected to City Office in Stockton.


Violation of California Business & Professions Code section 17200

Violation of the Voting Rights Acts of 1965, Section 2 & 5, prohibiting gerrymandering to disenfranchise a specific voting block.

Failure to follow the law with respect to the Stockton City Charter, which requires voting districts to be contiguous. The net result is that it is impossible for Mr. White to be re-elected to city office. In addition there is a failure to follow the city charter by not having the districts drawn within one-year of the election.
